

Intro to Piano

This fun introduction to playing the piano balances keyboard time with rhythmic drumming and listening games, which are fun ways to improve overall musicianship and encourage the learning process. Students must have access to a piano or keyboard, preferably full-sized at home for practice. Students will receive a piano book, practice CD and assignment binder.

Intro to Guitar

Learn the basics of playing the guitar in a fun group setting. Hand position, chording, melodies, note-reading, tabs and more will be covered. Students will receive a guitar book and assignment binder, but must provide own guitar.

Intro to Violin

Learn the basics plus some fun, unique ways of playing the violin in an encouraging group setting. Class goals include learning parts and proper care of the violin & bow, musical terms for string players, how to practice, and at least 3 basic tunes to play for family & friends. Students will receive a book and an assignment binder, but must provide their own violin. The last day of class is a family presentation.

Level I Intro classes are for students with little or no prior experience on the given instrument.
Level II Intro classes are for students who have completed the corresponding Level I class.

Kaleidoscope Choir
